Come, socialize, and create diamond art! All skill levels welcome. Registration is required due to limited supplies.

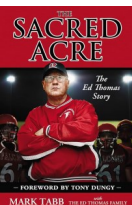
### Cookbook Club: April 18 at 6:30 pm

### True Crime Book Club:

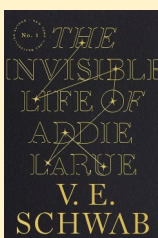
April 22 at 5:30 pm
