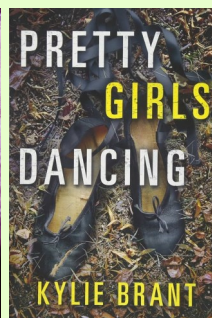
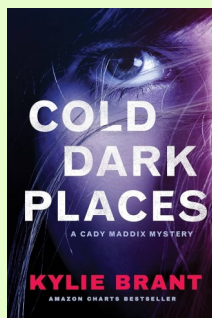
Loot Boxes and Bags
