**Fri:** 10 - 5

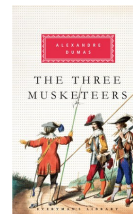

Come, socialize, and create diamond art! All skill levels welcome. Registration is required due to limited supplies.

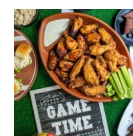
### Get Messy 2.0: Tuesdays at 3:30 pm

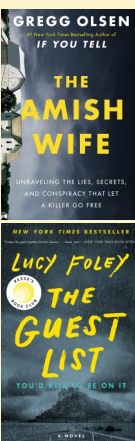


### Scrabble/Board Game Club:
